Below is a description of the college's merit scholarships for the current academic year. For most awards, we consider academic achievement only. For others, financial need is also considered.

Kettering College's merit-based scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis and are not guaranteed.

How do I apply?

All students admitted into a program are eligible, but check with your program chair to verify no additional documents are required.

Recipients of all scholarships are selected by department faculty.

Unless otherwise noted, all students must have at least a 3.0 GPA to be scholarship eligible.
