	Council for at least one year. Terms begin at the start of the f	_

Chair and Chair-Elect:	Elected to a three-year term by the Council. The first year of the term is served		
	as chair-elect with the previously elected chair. The second year is served as		
	chair without a chair-elect. During the spring of the second year of service a new chair-elect is elected by the Council. The third year is served as chair with the		
	newly-elected chair-elect.		
	The chair-elect is a member of the Council who assists the cha	air.	
Meeting Frequency:	Approximately monthly or at the call of the chair.
