Research

Purpose:	The Research Committee supports faculty and student research efforts with the intent that these research projects will enhance understanding in the area of inquiry and contribute to the general pool of knowledge which stems from academic research and scholarship. The research will be made public through conference presentations/poster presentations or journal publications.	
Status:	Permanent	
Membership:	<p>The committee will be composed of the following individuals (no more than 10 members) who hold interest in research activities at the college.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chair -who will serve a 3-year-term • 2-5 other faculty members, representing both graduate and undergraduate programs. • Dean (as determined by Administration) • Director of KHN Innovations, Research and Grants office or their designee. This member may send a representative in their stead when they are unable to attend meetings to keep informed, but any temporary representative will not have voting privileges. • Library Representative 	
Appointment:	Membership nomination and/or election administered by the Collegiate Life Committee.	
Membership:	Members will be added at the start of the fall semester and will only be added when membership is below maximum number and voted by approval of the current committee.	
Chair:	The committee will select a chair from the membership in the fall semester of the current Chair's 3 rd year in their leadership position. The Chair-elect will work with and learn from the current Chair during the winter semester of their Chair-elect term in an effort to support successful transition of leadership, prior to taking over the Chair position on the committee the following fall term	
Meeting Frequency:	The Research Committee will meet on a monthly basis or at the call of the chair.	
Minutes:	Distributed to the membership by the chair. The committee member responsible for taking minutes will share a copy of the minutes on the S:Drive in pdf format.	
Input From:	Network Innovation Center, Faculty	
Reports To:	Dean's Council, Graduate Council, and/or Executive Council on actions relating to research and/or scholarship that need institutional approval.

<p>Committee Procedures:</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Communicate all new proposals to College Council. 2. Provide periodic updates on ongoing projects to College Council. 3. Coordinate with individuals or groups that the College Council identifies as stakeholders in a given proposal, and with other individuals who indicate an interest in working on the proposal. 4. Provide advice, either as a whole or through appointment of a committee member, to workgroups dealing with issues that may affect or be affected by the committee. 5. Strive to reach consensus among its members and all stakeholders involved in a given proposal before making a final decision. 6. Notify the College Council of decisions made by the committee so that they may be communicated to the rest of the College. 7. Incorporate feedback received as a result of the College Council’s college-wide communications into proposals and continue to work toward consensus until a satisfactory result is achieved. 8. Review charter annually. Give an annual report of its goals and accomplishments to the General Assembly.
