OTD requires a GRE for entry into most programs, however, Kettering College OTD program does not require the GRE. Check with your Occupational Therapy graduate program of choice for requirements. NOTE: Students desiring admission to graduate programs should verify unique admissions requirements at the university of their choice.

The pre-OTD track is 123 hours.

PSYC 138 is required as a substitution for a HESC elective. PSYC 230 is required as an additional course.

The Bachelor of Science in Health Sciences requires at least 120 semester credits, including general education, with at least 40 semester credits in the upper division. Required major courses and elective major courses must total at least 40 semester credits, with at least 20 semester credits in the upper division; 68 credits must be taken at Kettering College.

There are two majors within this degree: Healthcare Management and Healthcare Studies.
